EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 2

Pursuant to the Declaration of Emergency adopted March 20, 2020, and for the reasons stated therein, it is hereby ORDERED as follows:

In addition to the items set forth in the initial Executive Order dated March 20, 2020, the following requirements shall be in effect until April 3, 2020:

Definitions:

Essential Healthcare Businesses are defined as the following:

- Health care operations, including hospitals, doctor offices, assisted living facilities, nursing homes, offices of practitioners of the healing arts, doctors, nurses, dentists, chiropractors, licensed physical therapists, research and laboratory operations and other medical facilities that are performing functions that are necessary to promote health within the City of Smyrna.

Direct Contact shall mean the state or condition of physical touching any part of the customer's body.


1. City parks remain open but within city parks, all pavilions, gazebos, playgrounds and meeting areas are closed. Individuals shall not utilize any city owned equipment in the parks including but not limited to playground or outdoor fitness equipment.
2. All businesses which are not defined as Essential Healthcare Businesses herein, where as a part of the normal business operation, employees have Direct Contact with customers are closed. These businesses include but are not limited to hair salons, barber shops, nail salons, spas, massage parlors and tattoo parlors.
3. The Executive Order Entered March 20, 2020 shall remain in full force and effect.

This executive order is effective at 8:00 PM on 24th day of March 2020.
