Today we're going to make a puppet, using only your hands and a few craft materials. Let your imagination run free! Our puppets had two eyes, but maybe yours has ten!

## Materials:

- 1 Pipe Cleaner
- Two Large Googly Eyes\*
- Craft Glue or Tape

## Optional:

- Pompons
- Markers.
- Feathers
- Whatever else you have at home!
- \* If you don't have googly eyes. you can make your own. Just draw some on cardstock and cut them out. Don't have cardstock? Use a paper plate or a cereal box.

- 1. Glue eyelashes, or other decorations to the back of your eyeball. Make sure to leave space to glue the eye stalks. You can also skip this step and go onto step two.
- 2. Fold a pipe cleaner in half and twist it into one piece.
- 3. Bend this twisted piece into a U shape. You can leave it like this or cut the ends to make the eye stalks a little shorter. It's up to you.
- 4. Tape or glue the eye stalks to your eye balls. If you glue them, allow time to dry.
- 5. Put your middle finger through U. so the eye stalks stick up on either side of your finger.
- 6. Hold your fingers tightly together to keep the eyeballs in place. Your hand will become the puppet. Your thumb is the mouth.
- 7. Put on a show. Have fun!
