Please note that Smyrna First United Methodist lots may not provide easy handicap access to the evening concert area on Atlanta Road because of secure stage areas and Church to King Street may be closed for a time during the evening concert. Fireworks viewing spots with handicap parking access are those lots closest to City Hall.
