ENGINEERING

Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon Installation:

Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFB) are being installed for an existing pedestrian crosswalk near the intersection of Ridge Road and Creatwood Trail. Our Traffic Signal Technicians began the installation of the unit facing westbound traffic on 12/19 and will finish the eastbound unit soon. This RRFB is part of improvements along Ridge Road recommended by Smyrna's Traffic Calming Committee. The RRFB flashes when the pedestrian button is pushed and is intended to bring awareness to pedestrians crossing Ridge Road. Pedestrian ahead signage was also installed for each approach on Ridge Road.






Vehicle Approaching When Flashing Device Installation: A Vehicle Approaching When Flashing (VAWF) device was installed at the intersection of Cooper Lake Road and Lakeview Terrace. The VAWF assembly will include a sign and flashing beacons that will flash when a vehicle is approaching from either direction on Cooper Lake Road. This device will help facilitate safe turns out of the subdivision by warning driver's when a car is approaching.

Traffic Signal Retiming Study: Updated signal timings have been implemented for the traffic signals along South Cobb Drive, Concord Road/Spring Road, and Atlanta Road. The traffic signals along this corridor were evaluated and updated by Kimley-Horn.

Infrastructure Repairs: Traffic signal lights have been replaced at numerous intersections, including SR 280 and The Crossings shopping center, SR 280 and Wisteria Lane, Concord Road and Old Concord Road, and Lake Park Drive and Lakewood Drive. Pedestrian signals have been repaired at SR 280 and Benson Poole Road, and Atlanta Road and Pat Mell Road.

Wondrous Winter Cleanup: The second Smyrna Wondrous Winter Cleanup was a huge success! Thirty-eight volunteers went out on six routes around the city on Saturday, December 17 to bring clean streets and good cheer to Smyrna for the holiday season. They picked up about 600 pounds of litter (150 pounds of which was recycled).

This was Keep Smyrna Beautiful's last litter cleanup of the year. Through our programs, over 18,700 pounds of litter were picked up from streets and trails in 2022!
