### **ENGINEERING**

**Infrastructure Repairs:** Our Traffic Signal Technicians have made numerous repairs to infrastructure that was hit during traffic accidents. These projects include the repair of the pedestrian signal used for the high-intensity activated crosswalk on South Cobb Drive, the repair of a rectangular rapid-flashing beacon system on Oakdale Road, and the repair of a pedestrian signal at the intersection of South Cobb Drive and Riverview Road/Maner Road. Upcoming projects include the repair to a pedestrian signal at the intersection of South Cobb Drive and Ridge Road.





**Speed Studies:** Speed studies will resume in January when schools reopen after the winter holidays. The Traffic Department conducted 21 speed studies this year.

**South Cobb Drive/SR 180 Street Name Sign Updates:** Progress has continued with the street name sign replacements along South Cobb Drive/SR 280. The signs at the signalized intersection of SR 280 and Powder Springs Street were replaced. South Cobb Drive and Cooper Lake Road is the last intersection scheduled for replacement this week.



### WATER DISTRIBUTION



**Work Orders:** Staff resolved several work orders last week including:

• Water Main Breaks: 1

• Sewer Backups: 2

• Water Service Leaks: 5

Water and Sewer staff take great pride in being responsible for the installation, repairs, and maintenance of 150 miles of sewer pipes, and 250 miles of water main pipes. We are currently providing services to 15,237 customers in the City of Smyrna. We guarantee above and beyond service, and safe clean water supply to each customer every day.

### WATER DISTRIBUTION

**Water Service Inventory Verification:** Water service inventory verification is underway. Homes in Wards 2, 4, and 6 are completed. Work in Ward 3 will begin soon

**Closed-Circuit TV Pipe Inspection:** Sewer infrastructure is being graded with closed-circuit TV equipment. This technology allows staff to view lines in real time, determine pipe conditions, and make corrections when necessary. Inspections in Wards 1, 2, 4, and 5 are completed. Inspections in Ward 6 are underway by Smyrna staff, and inspections in Ward 3 are underway by a contractor.

**Water Main and Service Replacement Projects:** Water mains and services are being replaced in several locations around the city.

- Highlands Drive: Complete with contractor working on landscaping restoration
- Glendale Circle: Complete
- Burbank Circle: Complete with contractor working on landscaping restoration
- Springwood Drive: In progress by contractor
- Bates Drive: Water test to take place on Friday to complete this project

**Congratulations:** Congratulations to Nathan Robinson (pictured right) on getting his Georgia water distribution license. Nate has been working with Water and Sewer for a year and is a very dedicated employee who helps oversee the distribution division. He was recently promoted to Field Operations Forman.

**Water Meter Change-Outs:** Water crews have been working on the remaining 100 residential meter change-outs to make our system 4G and up to date. The work is about 80% complete.

**Streets Department Projects:** The Streets Department has been working on the following projects:

- Continuing work on the batting cages at Ward Park
- Completed sidewalk repairs in the Heritage at Vinings subdivision
- Removed a fallen tree from a creek on South Cobb Drive
