Recycling Center: The Smyrna Recycling Center served 570 patrons last week.


WATER DISTRIBUTION

Water and Sewer staff take great pride in being responsible for the installation, repairs, and maintenance of 150 miles of sewer pipes and 250 miles of water main pipes. We are currently providing services to 15,237 customers in the City of Smyrna. We guarantee above and beyond service and safe, clean water supply to each customer every day.

Water Service Inventory Verification: Water service inventory verification is underway in Ward 7. Homes in Wards 2, 3, 4 and 6 are completed.


Water Main and Service Replacement Projects:

Customer Tips



Pressure Reducing Valve (PRV): When there is a water main break in the city or water is shut off to your home, it is recommended to keep all water spigots and faucets turned off until the water supply is fully restored. One common issue that homeowners experience during such situations is turning on water inside the house while the main water line is still turned off. This can lead to sediment from the water line accumulating in the screen of the PRV, resulting in low or no water flow until the PRV is cleaned or replaced.

Run Water After Vacation: A factor that affects water quality in your home is how "stale" the water is. When you leave your home or business for a long time, like on vacation, the water in the pipes and plumbing doesn't move. When you get back the best thing to do is to run the water on full blast for 30 seconds to two minutes before drinking or cooking. Side note: always use cold water for cooking to draw in fresh water from the outside.
