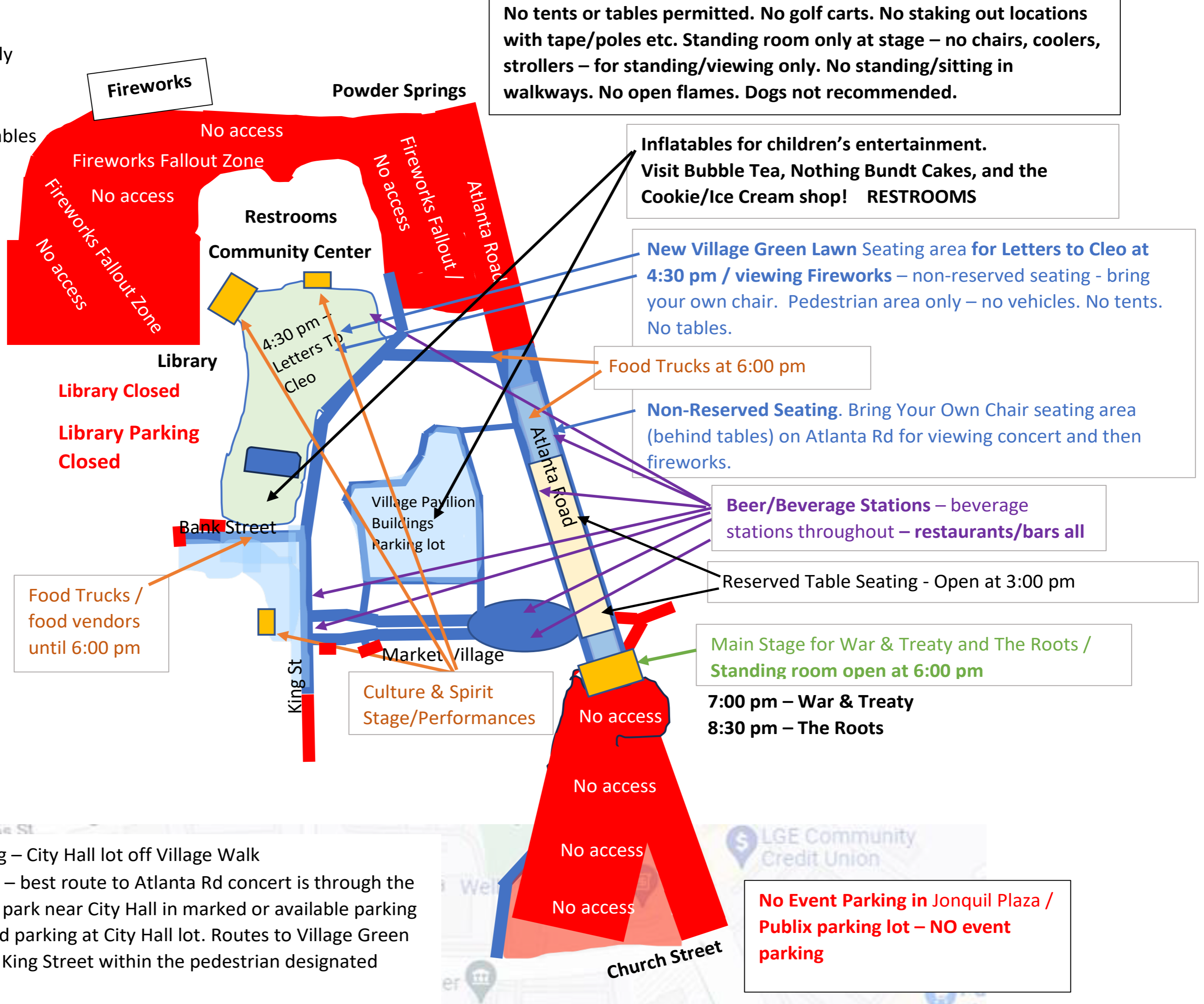

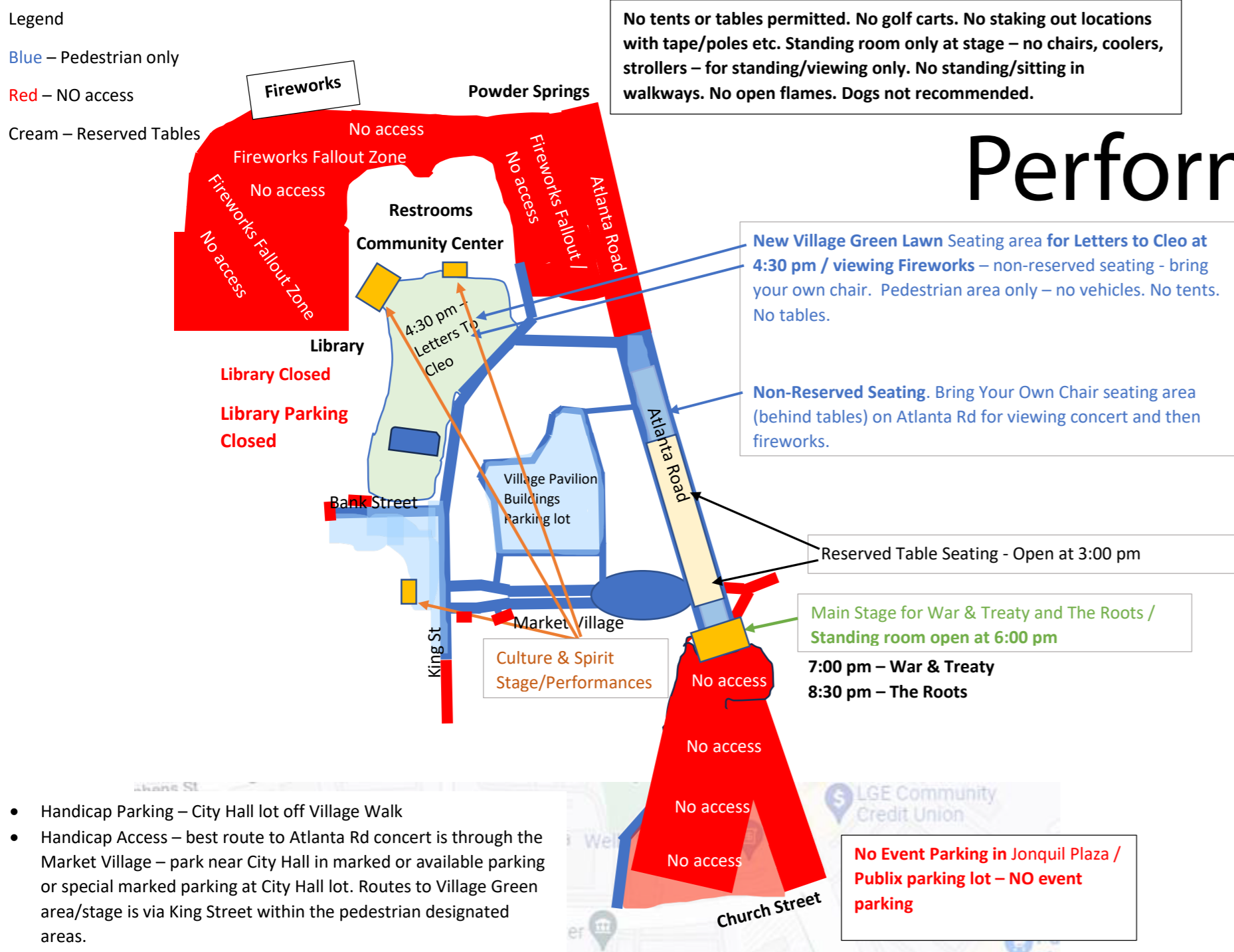
Legend

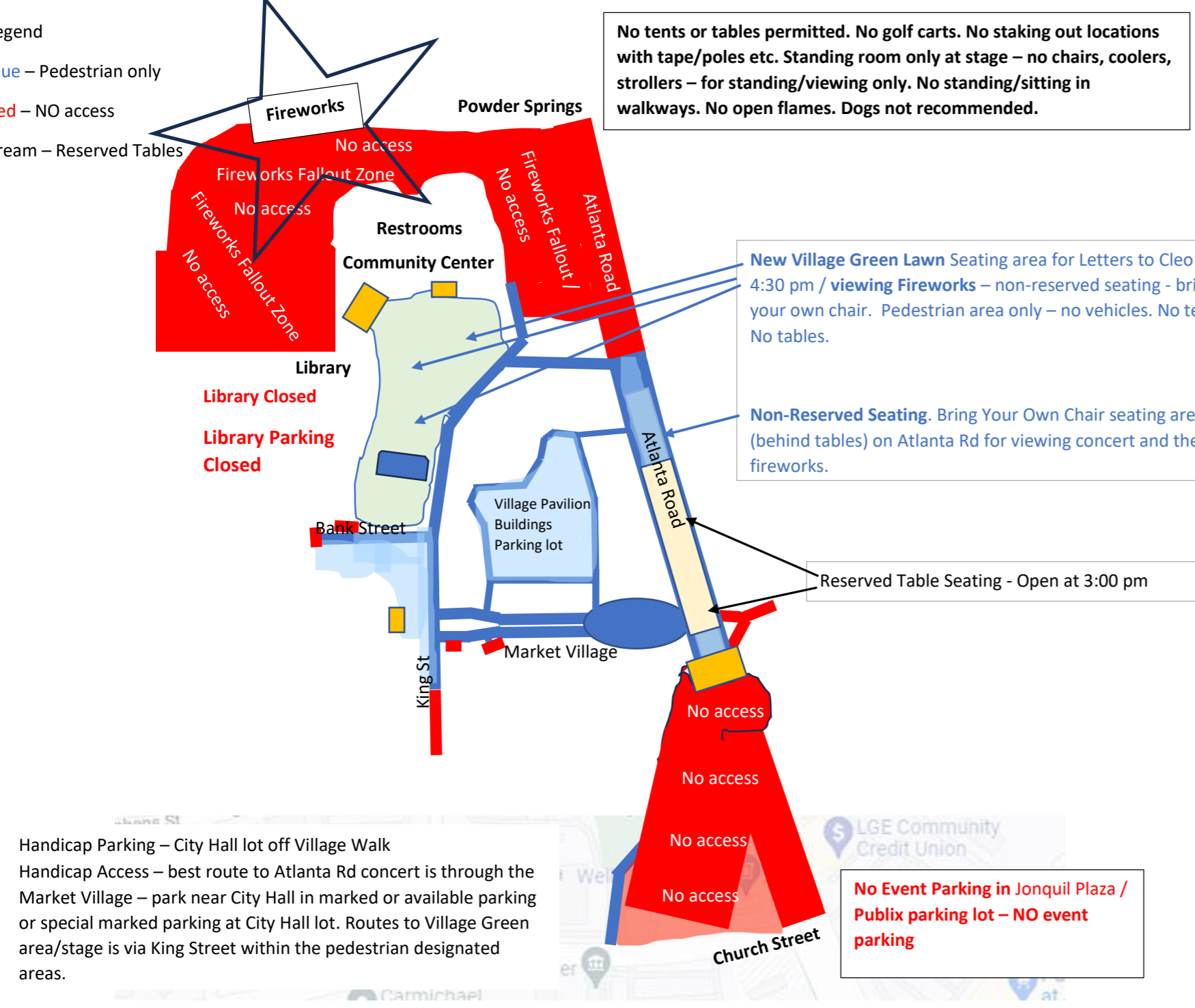
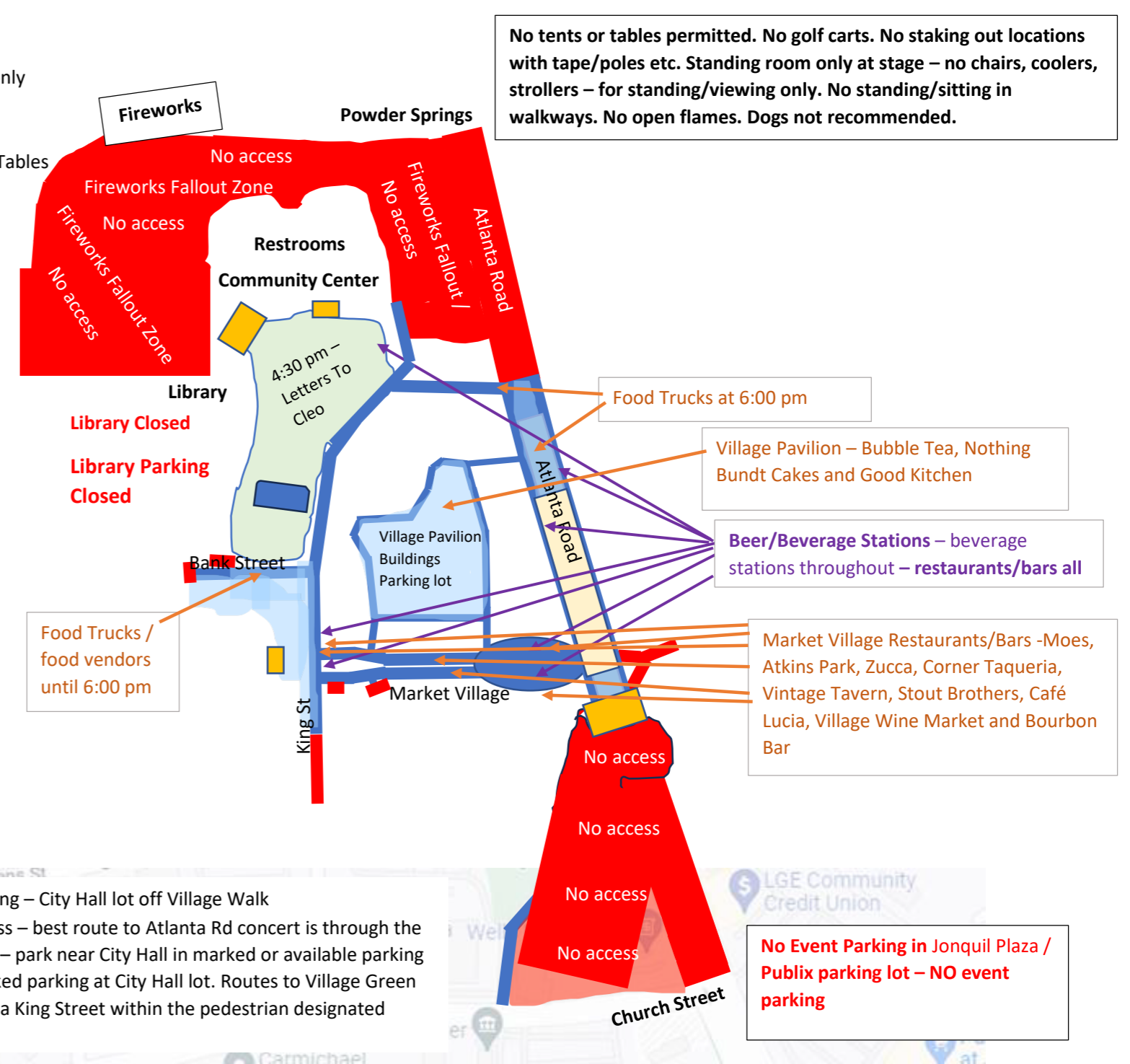

Parking

Designated Parking (while available):

- The Shops at Belmont
- Campbell High School (if not in use by School)
- Behind City Hall parking in the tiered lots along Village Walk
- Smyrna First Baptist Parking Lot(s)
- Smyrna First United Methodist Parking Lot(s)
- Handicap Parking (while available) is identified in various designated lots (listed above). For access to the City Hall area (Culture & Spirit Festival), use marked spots for City Hall lots. The Smyrna First Baptist lot adjacent to the Market Village has marked spots but only those already marked as handicap will be available in this lot. This lot is the closest to designated pedestrian areas for better access to Atlanta Rd through designated event space for the concert. Please note that Smyrna First United Methodist lots may not provide easy handicap access to the evening concert area on Atlanta Road because of secure stage areas and Church to King Street may be closed for a time during the evening concert. Fireworks viewing spots with handicap parking access are those lots closest to City Hall.

- Atlanta Rd & access street, lots/areas from Church to Powder Springs
- Library Lot
- Powder Springs Street
- Downtown areas including King St. from Concord to Bank St. from King to Village Walk, Market Village, and 300/400 Village Pavilion
- Jonquil Plaza/Publix, apartments & adjacent businesses
- Open businesses
- Streets not marked for parking
